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# Can Motorbike Accident Claims Help?

It is a fact that motorbikers represent a small number in traffic compared to the car drivers number. As a minority, they are often discriminated and the number of deaths among motorbikers is significantly higher than for other traffic participants. That is possible mainly because bikers have less protection. They generally suffer from head injuries which can lead to death.

One reason for their vulnerability is the total lack of safety. There is no safety belt and in case of accident the biker is projected ahead like a bullet. Even the slightest damage in the surface of the road can become a fatal weapon. Negligent drivers are virtual killers and as motorbikers are poorly visible in traffic it is no wonder they get hit.

All bikers must be aware of the behavior after an accident. When they are not badly injured and they recover their thinking, the first thing to do is call the police. The police report will be the first needed later on. Also, the police will note all the evidence, even the smallest of them. If you are not sure about this and still wonder if to make a claim for minor injuries and small damages, you should know that you can do it. It is your legal right.

You can make a claim especially if the accident was not from your fault. If you were partially guilty for it, you can still apply. Bring all the evidence that you did not surpass the speed and that you were wearing your protection gear.

The accident should be announced immediately to the police and to the insurer. Time for reporting is limited and your claim could not be valid if you surpass it.

If you were badly injured in the accident, you need to recover in hospital and follow your medical treatments. You need peace and quiet for a successful recovery and therefore you need all the support. It is best that you hire a motorbike accident solicitor to look after your compensation claim.

The insurance company should hear from you as soon as possible after an accident. An accident produces a lot of losses and you should calculate all of them. If other persons were involved in the accident with you, add their losses to the whole sum.

You can claim for personal injury, for property damage, for financial losses at work and for the pain and suffering. You can be very unhappy to see your beloved motorcycle badly damaged and it is only normal that you want to restore it to its original condition. You can add these expenses to your claim as well.

If, as a result of the accident, you were disabled and lost your work capacity, you are legally entitled to get compensated. Money represents only a small compensation for your losses but it helps you and your family to go on with your life.
