Winter Motorbike Riding Can Be Amusing If You Are All Set For The Ride.

December & January bike riding can be cool if you are geared up for the outing. Motorcycling in the colder months can offer a lot of original experiences and outlook that you won't see any other time of year. In the northern part of the United States you will in all probability see snow covered trees and hills. Whereas in the south you will come across a warmer Motorcycle ride and see winding roads and peaceful countrysides.

Coming from the north I possess a lot of knowledge motorcycling during the cold weather months. Motorbike riding year around, I have learned what you must recognize in order to be safe, warm and comfy while exposed on the street.

The primary thing you have to bear in mind is what the road conditions, temperature and wind chill factors are. Naturally if you are sure you want to go out riding on your bike in the winter, the roads should be free of ice and snow and you must dress accordingly. Consider when it's (30° f) out at 60 miles per hour the wind chill will be (10°F) and the lower the temperature goes down the colder the wind chill will be.

This is a method that you can apply to discern the wind chill for your motorcycle ride.

$$\text{WindChill}(\text{°F}) = 35.47 + 0.6215t - 35.75(V^{.16}) + 0.4375T(V^{.16})$$

Where, T = Air Temperature (°F)

V = Wind Speed (mph)

After that you should get dressed for the ride. Dressing for the ride means dressing in layers. Layers work much better as an insulation against the frigid cold and wind chill and if at any time along the way the temperature starts to heat up a bit you can pause and get rid of a layer or two. The external layer is probably the most valuable layer you should concern yourself about. It is the one that will protect you from the elements and the road if by some misfortune you should skid and lay your motorcycle down.

A lot of people opt to wear a snowmobile suit when they go out on a winter motorcycle ride. Whereas others will bundle up and wear the conventional hooded sweatshirt, leather motorcycle jacket and leather chaps. A full face mask and lined leather gloves are also greatly suggested. Like always a excellent solid pair of leather [motorcycle boots](#) and a warm pair of socks are a necessity. Remember though, if your socks are too heavy they can make your biker boots tight and interrupt your blood flow to your feet. This will have the reverse effect then your feet will get cold and freeze. I endorse lined motorcycle boots and a comfortable pair of socks.

One other item that truly helps keep you equally secure and warm while you motorcycle ride in the winter months is a full-faced motorbike helmet. A full faced helmet not only protects your head if you crash it also keeps the wind from your face and ears and that is a gigantic benefit when trying to keep warm on a icy ride.
